3. Oversee the Evangelism/Outreach of Student Ministries

- Ensure the overall expansion and growth of student ministry programs through creative, God-honoring outreach-oriented programming and events
- Develop and implement promotional strategies within the ministry
- Participate on local Junior High and Senior High School campuses
